



# ICCD Reopening and Guidelines for Daily Prayers and Jumma Prayers

## Jumma Prayers Registration

1. There will be ONE Jumma Prayer held in ICCD starting on Friday June 12, 2020 at 1:00pm.
2. The Khutbah/Prayer will be held in the third floor of the MCC.
3. Anyone under the age of 16 OR over the age of 65, cannot attend Jumma Prayer at this time. Additionally, if you are at all Immunocompromised or have any underlying medical conditions, please do not attend the prayer at this time. This includes: Diabetes, chronic kidney/liver disease, or heart conditions.
4. Jumma Prayer attendance is by registration only. Please see our website for Registration [www.iccdny.org](http://www.iccdny.org). Selection will be on a first come first serve basis.
5. Please note that there is no family registration. Everyone older than 16 AND under 65 must register individually.
6. A person may only register once. Once you register, your name is added to the rotation (Queue) and you will be notified when it is your turn to attend the prayer. Multiple registrations for the same name will disqualify you from attending.
7. If you didn't make the first week due to overcapacity, your name will automatically be rolled into next week. Please do not register again.

## On the day of Jumma Prayer

1. You must come to the MCC no earlier than 12:30pm. MCC doors will be closed at 1:00pm. Do not be late - You will not be able to get in.
2. Brothers and Sisters will enter the MCC from the Left entrance and exit from the Right Entrance.
3. You cannot attend the prayer if your name is not on the list. You cannot substitute for someone else. Your name must be on the list. No Exceptions.
4. The number of people attending the prayer will not exceed 100 including the Imam. (We will revisit this limit and may increase in the following weeks)
5. All restrooms including Wudu areas as well as other rooms in the MCC will be locked. **PLEASE MAKE SURE TO MAKE WUDU AT HOME.**
6. There will be clearly marked areas for people to stand and pray. Everyone must be in one of these designated areas.
7. Everyone will leave 15 minutes after the prayer is over after which the MCC doors will be closed.
8. Everyone must wear face masks— no exceptions. If someone doesn't have a proper face mask, they cannot come in. Everyone must bring their own prayer mats— no exceptions. If someone doesn't have a prayer mat, they cannot come in.
9. Everyone must bring a small bag for their shoes – no exceptions. Shoes will not be left in the shoe racks.
10. At all times, those attending the prayer will keep social distance including when entering and exiting the building.
11. No gathering, conversing, hanging out in the lobby or clustering the parking lot after the prayer is over.

12. The MCC banquet hall, lobby, all door handles, and contact areas will be disinfected after everyone leaves after each service.
13. Anyone with symptoms of Covid19 must self-declare and must not come to ICCD.
