



ICCD Reopening and Guidelines for Daily Prayers and Jumma Prayers

Rules for TWO Daily Prayers

1. At this time, we will reopen the Masjid for **TWO** daily prayers (Fajr and Maghrib) on a first come first serve basis starting Friday June 12, 2020.
2. If you have symptoms of Covid-19 please do not come to the Masjid.
3. Anyone under the age of 16 OR over the age of 65, cannot attend daily prayers at this time. Additionally, if you are at all Immunocompromised or have any underlying medical conditions, please do not attend the daily prayers. This includes: Diabetes, chronic kidney/liver disease, or heart conditions.
4. Everyone attending the prayer will line up with respecting the social distancing before the doors of the Masjid open.
5. Number of people attending prayer will not exceed 20, including the Imam.
6. All restrooms, Wudu areas and other rooms in the Masjid will be locked. **PLEASE MAKE SURE TO MAKE WUDU AT HOME.**
7. There will be clearly marked areas in the Musalla for people to stand and pray. Everyone must be in one of these designated areas.
8. Masjid will open its doors 15 minutes before each prayer.
9. Everyone will leave 15 minutes after the prayer is over after which Masjid doors will be closed.
10. Everyone must wear face masks– no exceptions. No entries allowed without facemasks.
11. Everyone must bring their own prayer mats– no exceptions. If someone doesn't have a prayer mat, they cannot come in.
12. At all times, those attending the prayer will keep social distance including when entering and exiting the building.
13. No gathering, conversing, hanging out in the lobby or clustering the parking lot after the prayer is over.
14. Musalla, including all the door handles, and contact areas will be disinfected after everyone leaves after each prayer.
